

BELLAHOUSTON PARK, GLASGOW Thursday 24th August 2017 5PM-11PM



Dear Local Resident,

Bellahouston Park will once again host Glasgow Summer Sessions in 2017. This year there will be only one show on Thursday 24th August: 5pm–11pm – EMINEM plus special guest Russ + Danny Brown + Run The Jewels

We understand the importance of communication with the local community and hope that by engaging positively with residents, we can minimise the impact of the event on the surrounding area. We have held a number of community engagement meetings which have enhanced our understanding of local issues and helped shape our plans for the event.

The Glasgow Summer Sessions site will be located in the South of Bellahouston Park, adjacent to Mosspark Boulevard. Following our community meetings with all surrounding community councils and local representatives we understand and appreciate the importance of maintaining public use and access to as much of the park as possible. For safety reasons and keeping in line with construction regulations, we will have to restrict access to certain areas of the park during the build and break of the event from 13th August until 29th August. Restricted pathways will be serviced by alternative routes, which will be clearly signposted.

TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS & LOCAL ACCESS ONLY

On the 24th August there will be Local Access Only Traffic Restrictions to deter concert goers from parking Maree Drive, Lugar Drive, Mosspark Boulevard* in your area. This will be in place in the following areas. DUMBRECK WEST: Dumbreck Square, Dumbreck Avenue, Dumbreck Place, Torridon Avenue West DUMBRECK EAST: Fleurs Avenue North. Fleurs Avenue South, Torridon Avenue East, Dargarvel Avenue North, Dargarvel Avenue South. Melfort Avenue. Torridon Avenue North, Erskine Avenue, Urrdale Road CESSNOCK: Midlock Street, Cessnock Street, Harley Street, Elizabeth Avenue

MOSSPARK: Mosspark Boulevard*, Arisaig Drive, Alness Crecent, Bellahouston Drive

CRAIGTON: Minto Crecent, Torbreck Street, Jura Street, Dunellan Street, Morven Street, Barfillan Drive, Maryland Drive

Kirkdale Drive, Moness Drive, Ladybank Drive,

If you reside in any of these streets noted above, you will find two local resident vehicle passes enclosed. Please safeguard your pass and hang this on your rear view mirror on Thursday 24th August to show that you are a local resident and give you unrestricted access to these roads. If you require any more vehicle passes then please contact us via the Local Resident's Enquiry Line or email us on GSSlocal@dfconcerts.co.uk. We do appreciate your co-operation in helping us to ensure parking spaces are reserved for locals.

Stewards will be deployed at nominated locations to maintain access for local residents. Stewards will be briefed to allow vehicles such as taxis and delivery vans access to restricted roads to minimise disruption for Local Residents.

ROAD CLOSURES

From Thursday 24th August the road closures below will be implemented. Full access will still be available to residents and businesses on these streets:

- Mosspark Boulevard will be closed from 10am–2am
- Bellahouston Drive southbound from Paislev Road West to Mosspark Boulevard will be closed from 10am-2am

On Thursday 24th August Dumbreck Road between Paisley Road West and Mosspark Boulevard will be closed from 22.15 to ALL traffic for safety reasons as

the large crowds leave the park. Police Scotland will determine the reopening time, however it is estimated the closure may last until midnight.

For the duration of Glasgow Summer Sessions, monitoring of noise levels to the licensed limits will take place in your area. Glasgow City Council staff will also be present and will be assisting DF Concerts with the control and management of noise levels.

Some performance noise may be experienced in the surrounding areas. In addition to this the artist may use stage effects that make sounds similar to fireworks being set off. This will occur between 6pm-8pm on 23rd August and 9pm-11pm on 24th August. Should you have any concerns about noise please get in touch with ourselves or the Glasgow City Council out of hours team.
